VIDEO REACTION: A secondary component of the TV episode analysis assignment is the discussion of alternate media and sources, including Everyman-type reviews. As such, students will be required to complete an analysis of a work of art/media that illustrates their chosen social issue. This analysis will be submitted in the form of a reaction video.

Go to YouTube and search for videos using terms related to your semester's topic--your socio-political issue. Choose a video and watch it, recording yourself as you watch. You can pause/comment on the video as you go, noting something of interest, asking a question, or stating an alternative opinion. Feel free to include others (like family members, friends) in the video/discussion.

If you and a fellow classmate are writing on the same socio-political issue and want to do this assignment together, you may.
